- a group of people (nevbent) played music five or three times a day for the sultan, or khan in front of the palace or near arm of the empire.

- When there is a victory, festivals are organized free.
- During religious time esp at nights hymes and religious songs were sang.
- During dervish shows
- When sultan changes there were special ceremonies with music
- At some of the literal and religious meetings
- Music was so developed that many different kinds of it occured and we can say that seljukian music is the basis of modern Turkish Music.
