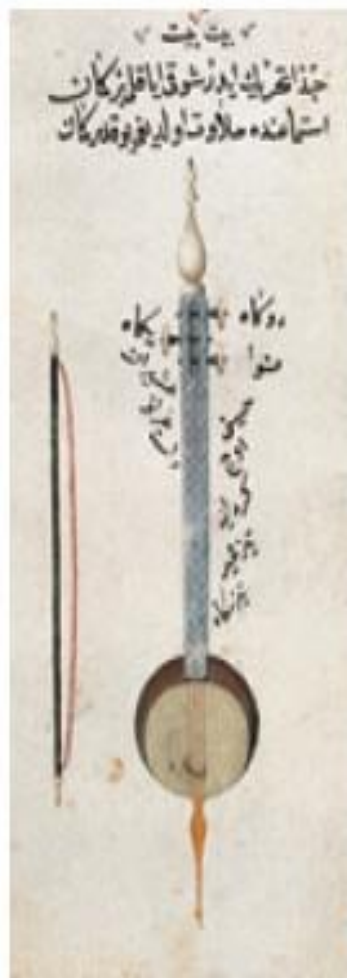
- ◉ It is believed that different tunes and rhythms of the music can heal illnesses

- ◉ When there is a victory, festivals are organized free.
- ◉ During religious time esp at nights hymes and religious songs were sang.
- ◉ During dervish shows
- ◉ When sultan changes there were special ceremonies with music
- ◉ At some of the literal and religious meetings
- ◉ Music was so developed that many different kinds of it occured and we can say that seljukian music is the basis of modern Turkish Music.

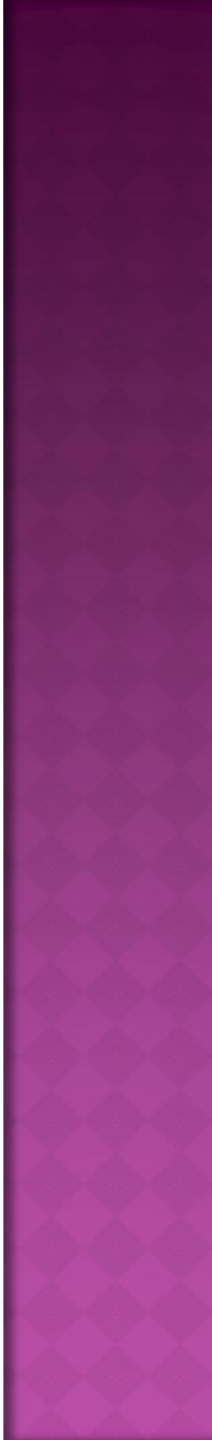

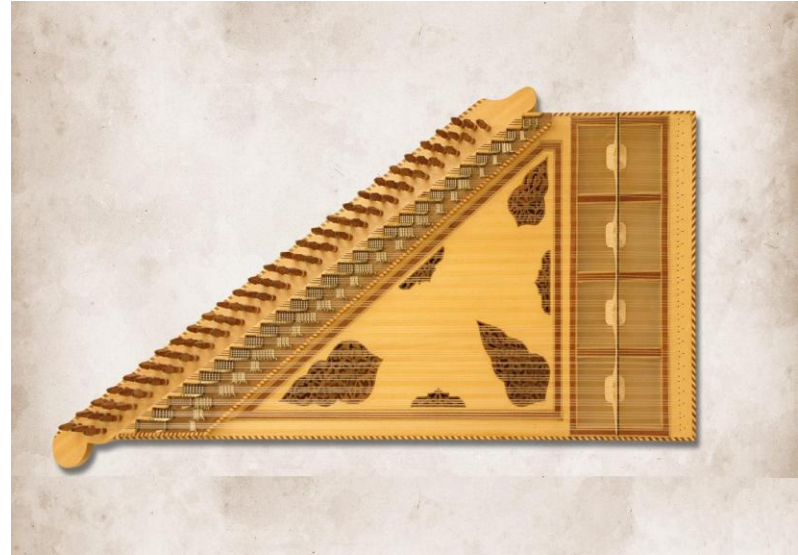
