

Vogaskóli is a compulsory school with students of ages 6 - 16. Students are around 300 this school year and the staff is around 40, with 25 teachers. The students come from the neighborhood, most of them middle class. Vogaskóli is situated in Reykjavík, capital city of Iceland.

In Vogaskóli children with special needs are in the same classes with other children. The students start to learn English in 4th grade, and Danish in 7th grade. They are in art classes from 1st grade to 8th grade, after that they have a choice among various courses. The school has good equipment for ICT. The older students have access to Kindle and Ipad.

The school hasn't taken part in any other Comenius project, so this is a good opportunity for teachers to work with colleagues from other parts of Europe and also for students to take part in a project that students from other countries are also working on.

Students can work on this project in English, history, ICT. They will bring to life the Icelandic history with their project by using ICT, field trips and other activities. This project is linked to our curriculum, and this is a way to bring it alive, but also to look at Icelandic history, and the history of Europe in context.
